PETITION TO REMOVE AREA FROM JENNINGS NORTHWEST
REGIONAL UTILITIES' TERRITORIAL SERVICE AREA

Comes now, Jennings Northwest Regional Utilities ("JNRU"), a regional water and sewer district, organized and operating under Indiana Code 13-26, et seq., by its Board of Trustees, and petitions the Indiana Department of Environmental Management ("IDEM") for authority to remove certain territory from the jurisdictional boundaries of JNRU's service area in Jennings County, Indiana, and to redefine said service territory to that of Country Squire Lakes Subdivision, as platted in the records of the Jennings County Recorder and a few other properties currently served by the district, which reduced service territory shall include only the real estate described in the attached exhibit. In support of said Petition, JNRU would show IDEM the following:

1. That JNRU was duly organized under Indiana Code 13-26-2-1, et seq., pursuant to an Order forming the district issued by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, on or about November 4, 1996.

2. That included in the sewer service territory over which JNRU acquired jurisdiction is real estate located in Geneva, Center and Sandcreek Townships, Jennings County, State of Indiana.

3. That JNRU has performed numerous extensive professional engineering studies as to the feasibility of providing sewer service to all of the areas within its District, which areas lie outside of its current customer area.

4. That at the present time, said Board of Trustees of JNRU has determined it is not economically feasible to provide sewer service to the areas outside of its current customer area.

5. That many of the residents and property owners currently not served by JNRU within this designated service territory, have repeatedly requested that their property **NOT** be served by JNRU's sewer utility and have requested that said properties be removed from JNRU's territorial service district.

6. That the Board of Trustees, having considered said requests, has determined it to be in the best interests of JNRU that the JNRU district service territory be reduced to the areas currently served by the district, namely the Country Squire Lakes Subdivision, as platted in the office of the Jennings County Recorder, and a few customers adjacent thereto, and that all other territory be removed from the jurisdictional service area of JNRU, which reduced service territory is described in the attached exhibit.

7. JNRU, by its Board of Trustees, hereby requests that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management remove all other real estate from the sewer territorial service area of JNRU, and to redefine said sewer territory to that as described in the attached exhibit.



EXHIBIT

DESCRIPTION OF NEW
JENNINGS NORTHWEST REGIONAL UTILITIES' SERVICE AREA

The following real estate located in Jennings County, Indiana, to-wit: beginning at the intersection of State Road 7 (SR7) and County Road 300 North (CR 300N); thence proceeding northwest along SR7 approximately 0.32 of a mile to the southwest corner of Decatur Mold real estate (See Plat Cabinet 2, Slide 151); thence running along the Decatur Mold real estate for the next three courses, northeast approximately 0.2 of a mile, northwest approximately 0.19 of a mile, southwest approximately 0.25 of a mile to SR7; thence turning northwest along SR7 and running approximately 1.63 miles to the northern boundary of Country Squire Lakes Subdivision real estate (CSL). From this point turning west and running along the existing CSL Subdivision northern property boundary, running west and south to the CSL Subdivision boundary intersection with County Road 500 West (CR 500W) and County Road 400 North (CR 400N); thence running south along CR 500W to the intersection of CR 500W with CR 300N; thence continuing south approximately 0.5 of a mile; thence running east approximately 0.5 of a mile; thence north approximately 0.5 of a mile to the intersection with CR 300N; thence running east along CR 300N to the point of beginning at the intersection of SR7 and CR 300N. Total area of the described boundaries equal approximately **3.0 square miles or 1920 acres.**
